







### THE EXCHANGE RATE






- Has influenced box office returns

# THEATRICAL DISTRIBUTION



- Independent distribution is under threat




### CINEMA EXHIBITION

# REGIONAL FILM PRODUCTION




More films and higher attendance

#### DOMESTIC FILM MARKET


