

STATE SUPPORT FOR THE FILM INDUSTRY


The Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation

- Financial support of the production and distribution of films for children, debut films, artistic and experimental films, newsreels, documentaries, educational films, and animated films
- Promotion of domestic cinema
- Purchase of imported 35-mm film reel
- Research and experimental studies in the field of cinema

Cinema Fund

- -Film financing of the leading domestic producers (8 companies)
- -Financing the production of films containing patriotic subject matter
- -Support of film companies making films of artistic and cultural significance where cinema viewing figures exceeded 1 million
- -Financial support of Russian films appearing at film festivals and film markets

DOMESTIC FILM PRODUCTION

- About 70 domestic films in Russian distribution in 2010
- Average production budget: EUR 3.1m (from EUR 75,000 to 26,000,000)
- Average box office return: EUR 2.6m (from EUR 300 to 17,400,000)
- Share of domestic film in Russian box-office drops – 16.3% in 2010



- Average box office return: EUR 0.7m (from EUR 1,800 to 3,400,000)


Countries participating in co-productions with Russia, by number of films in Russian distribution in 2010







Number of releases in Russian distribution, by country of production, 2010





Box office returns for films in Russian distribution, by country of production, 2010



VIDEO DISTRIBUTION & VoD

- Video sales in 2010 up 5% (down 9% in 2009)
- BD vs DVD releases in 2010: 14% vs 86% (10% vs 90% in 2009)

- About 40 VoD operators in 2010 (including 20 on the Internet)
- Upsurge in the number of Internet services (advertising, subscription and pay per view business models)
